Regular Meeting

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick.

The Open Space account was discussed with Dianne, the actual account is in a long term C.D. that expires in July, 1981, However, \$27,545.96 has been placed in a savings account earning 5% interest. It was agreed by the Selectmen that Dianne place the money in a 45 day C.D. to acquire a 11% interest, until monies are transferable from the actual account to the checking account.

John Beaudoin in to discuss the Youth League Park on the Old Alfred Rd. The field is to be fertilized, monies to be taken from the Incidental account. The matter of watering the field will be discuss and a decision will be made on the account the monies will be taken from to cover this expenditure.

Three Representatives from the York County Mud Stompers Road Rally II, in to discuss an up coming Rally. It had been brought to the Selectmen's attention that the following roads in Waterboro would be used, Bagley Rd., Lake Sherbourne Rd, Thyngs Mills Rd., complaints had been made by property owners along the planned route. A map of the proposed course was reviewed and Selectmen asked that the above mentioned roads be deleted from the course, because of their muddy conditions, this time of the year. The President of the Asso. stated that the Roads in Waterboro would be dropped from the planned course. He said the club had discussed purchasing 110 acres of property in So. Waterboro for the purpose of making it into a Mud Hill Climb Track. Mr. Woodsome gave them a copy of the Town's Ordinance on Race Tracks, etc.

James Bauer, in with an abatement request on his property on Chadbourne Ridge Rd., this will be considered at a later date.

Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean in with payroll and discussed the condition of the Town Dump. He said he felt the stumps and brush should be burned. He was advised by the Selectmen to have the Fire Dept. there if this was going to be burned.
