Supervisor Norman Manwell, Bureau of Parks & Recreation will be sent the Deed to the property the Town is purchasing from the State to have a section rewritten as per Roger Elliott's letter dated June 16, 1981. "Rte. 5 Picnic Area".

Bureau of Forestry- called, David Struble will send the Town a letter stating that the Town did not refuse monies to spray for Gypsy Moth. Mr. Struble also said that the Town must raise all the money needed to spray then wait and see if the Federal Government allocates monies for the Bureau to reimburse Town's. A survey will be sent out to Waterboro and surrounding towns showing the areas that the Bureau feels needs spraying.
