Guillemette Bros. from Sanford were in concerning their Mother's land Map 9 Lot 22B. They brought copies of old deeds and letters from their lawyer showing that the land belonged to Oliver Guillemette. Selectmen said that they would have the Treasurer send them a total on three years of back taxes and have the Town lawyer draw up quit claim deeds in Alice Guillemette name, which are to be paid for by the Guillemettes. This paper work would release the liens and place the property in Mrs. Guillemettes name, Oliver Guillemette is deceased.

In the near future the Guillemettes are going to have the land surveyed and will at that time furnish the Town with a copy of the survey.

Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean: In with the payroll and discussed the condition of several roads with the Selectmen.

L.A.E. Town owned lots: Lots that have sale agreements are # A271, A272, A273, 948, 949, 1669, 1742, 930, 931, 932. Chmn. Fay had already signed #1669, #A271, A272, A273. Woodsome said he would check the lots out on the waterfront before agreeing to signing the sales agreements. It was voted unanimously that the Town not sell Lots #930, 931, 932, these three lots will be removed from the listing.

Cable T.V. A three Town committee will be formed to study the feasibility of Cable T.V., Hollis, Buxton & Waterboro. The Board of Selectmen appointed Andrew Woodsome, Jr. to represent Waterboro on the committee.

Cemetery; Shawn Edgcombe was called by Chmn. Fay and asked if he wished to continue mowing the Town Cemetery and the triangle at the Waterboro Center and Shawn said he did not want the job. Chris Beaudoin will be called and asked to do the job.
