Michael Zsiga to sent a copy of a report on the funds available to the Town regarding construction of State Aid Rds. and Reconstruction of State Aid Rds. Estimated figures available for reconstruction is \$22,075.14, if used for construction the Town would lose approximately \$10,000.00

Waterboro Historical Society was given permission to have a food and craft table at the Nov. election.


Council meeting canceled for the month of August.
