Friends II is located in Sanford, Me. He said he had no intentions on opening a bar and selling hard liquor. Town Clerk, Dianne Holden stated that before Mr. LeTourneau was issued a victulars license, since he intended in the near future to apply for a malt license she felt that the septage problem on the property should be checked and operating sufficently.
