8:15 pm: Discontinuance of the section of road known as Old Rte. 202 & 4 bounded by Lots 45, 46 & 47 as shown on Map 4 of the Town of Waterboro Assessor's Maps.

Dyers and Roberts, abutters, requested hearing. Arlene Searles presented a letter signed by all residents of road requesting that road not be discontinued.

Road to be presented at the 1982 Annual Town Meeting for vote.

8:30 pm: Discontinuance of the section of road so-called Old Route 202 & 4, located on the North corner of Straw Mill Brook Road and Rte. 202 & 4, bounded by lots 26, 27 & 29 on Map 4 of the Town of Waterboro Assessor's Maps.

Bennett, abuttor, requested hearing. Selectmen gave permission to block off road and will instruct the Road Commissioner to do so. Discontinuance to be presented at the 1982 Annual Town Meeting for vote.
