

Dist. Atty. Office to be called for the legal views of the Town of Waterboro Parking Ordinance. The Ordinance was taken to the Dist. Atty. two weeks ago by Deputy Boyinton for his review.

Garnsey Bros. Ins. Co. Representative Roger Couture was called by Selectman Woodsome in regards to the Insurance on the Old Elementary Bldg. on Rte. 202 in So. Waterboro. Mr. Couture told Woodsome that his main concern was with the contents of the building and the increased value do to the revamping of the building. Mr. Woodsome informed Mr. Couture that the contents had nothing to do with the Town of Waterboro and that the only concern that he (Woodsome) felt the Town of Waterboro would have is that there be a policy covering the building in the amount of \$25,000. Mr. Woodsome contacted John Champion, Lions Club member and Mr. Champion will bring a copy of the Club's Policy into the Town Office for the Town's records. The Massabesic Lions Club holds a lease to the building to be used as an area Medical Center.
