

SELECTMEN'S MEETING  
MINUTES

Nov. 17, 1981

Present: Chmn Robert Fay, Andrew Woodsome, Jr, Jean Chick

Melbert Bennett , Stephen Waterhouse and Ann Isaac in to discuss the barriers that the Selectmen had told Bennett to install at the end of the portion of Old Rte 202 & 4 in front of their property. Bennett was told to close off the end toward East Waterbor and that the actual fate of the road would be decided at Annual Town Meeting in March. Woodsome said he would take the necessary steps to have deeds made out by the Town Atty, to give the road to the abutters if the Townspeople decided to close the road. Both Bennett and Waterhouse decided that they wanted to receive the land and Waterhouse would then have to build his own drive way entry to his house.

Merton Brakett, Division Engineer from the State Highway Division in to discuss the swapping of a portion of Rte 5 from Clint's Marine to Waterboro Center of 1.6 miles of winter maintenance for 2.6 miles of Rte 202 & 4 in So. Waterboro. He said the law clearly states that the municipality is responsible for maintenance of the compact areas. Woodsome asked if there was any possibility of hiring the State to do the plowing. Brackett said the State is not going to do any contracting that he knew of. And that the State has 1600 miles of State Aid Roads of which 500 miles to be turned back to the municipalities.

Robert Abbott snow removal contractor for the northern section of Town in to tell Selectmen that unless the turn around at the end of the road he lives on was fixed he would not plow the road. Glenn Bean , Rd. Comm. said it would be fixed. School bus turnarounds discussed and Abbott said he would not plow on the Fallon property or Merrill's Store. He was told that the school bus coordinator Kellett would be called on this.

Amendments were made to the Town of Waterboro Parking and Traffic Ordinance Adopted Oct. 14, 1972. to include:

1. Add, No Parking Tow Zone.
2. Add, No Parking Tow Zone.
3. Add, No Parking Tow Zone.

South Waterboro- Parking to be prohibited from the right-a-way of Pine Drive for a distance of 35 feet east along Route 202 & 4 , from the easterly corner of property now owned by Roger Chick for a distance of 35 feet westerly along Route 202 & 4. With the intent to keep drive and entrances clear for visibility and access. This area declared a No Parking Tow Zone.

South Waterboro- Parking to be prohibited from the westerly corner of the Milk Room property for a distance of 35 feet westerly along Route 202 & 4. With the intent to keep drive and entrances clear for visibility and access. This area declared No Parking Tow Zone.


An Agreement signed by the Selectmen and sent to David Silva, Sr. for his signature on the property Silva owns on the Ossipee Hill Rd. The Town of Waterboro agrees to put the stone wall back to its original condition. Driveway entry to be put over culvert by Pole #345. Town will maintain grade of driveway to existing level of road. After completion of construction on the Ossipee Hill Rd.

Bid letters to be sent to the two present snow removal contractors for bids on the section of road from Clint's Marine to Waterboro Center. For the winter of 1982/83.

Rd. Comm. Bean was asked to please install the No Parking signs in So. Waterboro on Pine Dr. and Rte 202. Also to deliver the wood to two General Assistance cases.
