Meeting opened by Chmn. Fay, reporting on the following:

1. Swapping of 1.6 miles of winter maintenance on Rte. 5 from Clint's Marine to Waterboro Center for 2.6 miles on Rte 202 & 4 in So. Waterboro, section to go out for bids, for the winter of 1982/83. Also that the State will be turning back some of the State Aid rds. to the Town, Federal St., Chadbourne Ridge Rd, Old Corner to Ross Corner of the West Rd. and a section of Clark's Bridge Rd.
2. Stump Dump to be completed by Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean, Sr.
3. Deed being prepared for the Wiggins property by the Picnic Area on Rte 5.
4. Special Town Meeting to raise monies for construction of Ledgemere Bridge. Selectmen Woodsome say that the monies could be raised at Annual Town Meeting, but for the Project to be started in early spring all necessary permits with the Federal, Local, State and Coast Guard had to be done.

Planning Board: Member Roland Deny reported on a meeting he had attended at the Court House with D.E.P. and S.M.R.P.C. on Mobile homes regulations regarding municipal zoning.

James Hamilton reported on sites that have been declared usable for septage dumping. He feels that the Town should seriously look into the site across from the transfer station. He said that even though the Town of Sanford will take Waterboro Septage they may not be able to indiffenitly, therefore, the Town should consider having a site for dumping.

Constable, Waterhouse said everything quiet in Town.  
Rd. Comm.: Bean said he was working on several projects, getting school bus turnarounds ready, finishing the Stump Dump and Transfer Station road. He stated he did not have the winter stockpile ready as yet.

Frank Goodwin reported that the S.M.R.P.C. would have to ask the municipality for monies this year as they had been cut off on funds by the County.

Finance Comm, Chmn. Willett said the Committee would be meeting soon to work on the 1982 budget.

Charter Comm, Chm. Willett said the preliminary charter coming along fine and would have the report ready for a public hearing shortly.


ZBA, ~~member~~ Darling said there was nothing to report.

Planning Bd.Chmn Goodwin said the zoning revisions are ready to be presented to the Selectmen for them to send to the Town Atty. for his review and public hearing to be held soon.
