Letter to go to Robert Abbott for a price of plowing the extension of Bennett Hill Rd. from the old dump to the new dump and into the stump dump.


Agreement from David Silva, Sr. on land abutting Ossipee Hill Rd. received and filed.

Special Town Meeting held at 8:00 pm., Voted and passed an Article to raise \$7,000. from 1982 taxation to construct Ledgemere Bridge. Form signed by the Selectmen to proceed with the construction of the Ledgemere Station Bridge according to Title 23 of the S.M.R.S. Subchapter VI. The Town to make payment for 25% (\$9,500) of their estimated project cost through their State Aid account.

Limerick Selectmen called following their Town Mtg. held the same time as Waterboro's. Selectman Chamberlain said that Limerick got the go ahead with the Project also, but will raise their extra monies at their Annual Town Meeting in March of 1982.
