Daniel Willett, Finance Comm. Chmn. in to inform the Selectmen that Mr. Bien of Canal Bank had called him and that the TAN interest would be 9½% also inquired why so many delinquent taxes and if the Town would be raising the interest on late payments of taxes this year to 23%.

Lesley Leighton in to ask Selectmen the next step he should take after receiving correspondence from Dept. Environmental Protection with their decision approving his apartment building application. Monteith told Leighton that all interested parties would receive copies of the letter from D.E.P. and to apply for any necessary building permits from the Building Inspector.

Arthur Grantham, Dayton Road Commissioner in with prices of clay and loam for reclaiming the Old Town Dump. He said he felt the prices would remain the same in the spring. He quoted \$3.85 a yard for Clay delivered, and \$5.00 to \$5.50 for loam delivered, (this would be loam that had been stripped from the top of the clay). Chmn. Fay to call Sarah Vetault to get specs that D.E.P. sets up for reclaiming old dumps. Mr. Grantham said he would be interested in bidding on the project in the spring.

Contract with C.M.P. reviewed and the Selectmen agreed that some changes were to be made before signing. The power to run the equipment, etc., the Selectmen agree should be billed to R.L. Stevens of Customs Transfer, Co. not the Town of Waterboro.


Articles for Town Meeting discussed. It was decided to submit a separate article for Vehicle Registration.
