## MINUTES

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, John Monteith, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Jean Chick.

Mr. & Mrs. Leland Swett: The Selectmen had invited the Swett's to attend the meeting to inform them of the public hearing held on Tuesday, 7:30 pm. Jan. 19th. It was the decision of the majority present at the hearing that an article be placed on the Warrant to be brought before the Townspeople at Annual Town Meeting to take by eminent domain a 10 foot strip of the Swett's property to widen Pine Drive. Mr. Swett said he owned 20 feet of land between his house and Pine Drive and did not want to give any of it up. He said he felt Pine Drive is wide enough for the passage of two vehicles and that certainly it is as wide as if not wider than a lot of Town roads. The Swett's were informed that the Town attorney Roger Elliott would be at the Feb. 2nd. Selectmen's meeting and that they along with Michael Hammond were invited to attend to ask any questions and hear Mr. Elliott's opinion on the article wording, etc.

FEDERAL REVENUE SHARING HEARING, held at 7:30 pm., No comments, passed as written.

Glenn Bean, Rd. Comm: He informed the Selectmen that he had one cord of wood left of Town wood for General Assistance.

Byrant Steel Works to be called and asked for the price of sanders.


Selectman Woodsome said he wanted to bring up to the Planning Board that any subdivision on State Highways, such as Rte's. 202 & 5 must have a buffer zone so that the area can not be declared a compact area.

Chmn. Fay said that Robert Abbott had agreed to plow the Picnic Area on Rte 202 in E. Waterboro for \$100.00.

Discussion held on the so called Grace Remy lot, Map 15 Lot 9 on the Assessor's maps, as to ownership, either by the Town of Waterboro or James Foss of Limerick. Selectmen will decide whether they will bill Mr. Foss for the 1942, 43 taxes plus interest and three years back taxes or offer him a price for legal purchase of the land in question.

Selectmen attended the final Finance Committee meeting.
