Parking Ordinance passed as follows;

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE PARKING WITHIN THE TOWN OF WATERBORO
Parking of motor vehicles to be prohibited on the North Easterly side of Pine Drive in South Waterboro and to be declared a "No Parking Tow Zone".

This Ordinance shall be effective on the date of its adoption by the Municipal Officers of the Town of Waterboro.
Passed Feb. 23, 1982.

Cable Television Amendments to the existing Ordinance passed as follows:

PUBLIC HEARING

Feb. 23, 1982

Public Hearing held at 7:00 pm. for the purpose of enacting an Ordinance to regulate parking within the Town of Waterboro.

Approximately 80 citizens in attendance.

Hearing opened by Chman. Robert Fay.

Chmn. Fay read a letter sent to the State in Sept. 1981, asking their people to check the traffic problems in So. Waterboro.


The meeting was then chaired by Selectman Woodsome. Woodsome read the Proposed Parking Ordinance and a letter received from Atty. Roger Elliott pertaining to taking of the Swett property by eminent domain to widen Pine Drive.

Discussion held on unloading hours and safety. Several citizens voiced their opinions on the Town's regulating times of deliveries. Michael Hammond offered to furnish the paint and the labor to paint a center line on Pine Drive. And the consensus was to adapt an Ordinance for "No Parking Tow Zone", on the North Easterly side of Pine Drive only, the homeowners on Pine Drive were asked by Woodsome if they would agree to this and Leonard Bean, Dawn Vinton and Raymond Gray said that they would agree to the Ordinance reading that the North Easterly side be kept open at all times as long as it was passable and they were able to travel the road to reach there property.

Passed as written.


