MINUTES

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, John Montieth, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Jean Chick

Wendell Currier: Mr. Currier had been in earlier in the week to find out the status of the name change for the road leading from Waterboro into Hollis, the Hollis Selectmwn had already given their approval for the change from Deering Ridge Rd. to the Edith Hughey Rd. Waterboro' name for the road is "Cross Rd" or "Deerwander Rd". Selectmen agreed that Town Attorney Elliott should be called for his comments on this. (Atty. Elliott called the next day and his opinion was that the Town can change the name of a Town road but that the action should go through a Town Meeting.)

Atty. Elliott: Elliott to be called in referance to the Claims registered at the Registry of Deeds in Alfred in October of 1975. On land to be taken by adverse possession. (Mr. Elliott was called and he reserved and opinions until he is sent copies of the registered claims as they are recorded at the Registry of Deeds.

Nancy Thornton: Mrs. Thornton is to be called and asked to bring in the \$15.00 fee for a concealed weapons permit issued in her name and to pick up a check made out to the Town of Waterboro for \$30.00 that was submitted for two applications, one being denied.

Glenn Bean Rd. Comm. Selectmen asked that he contact the snow-plowing Contractors and ask that they plow some of the roads that have drifted in. Roads mentioned were, Clark's Bridge Rd, Roberts Ridge and Pole Line road by Maurice Swett's. Bean said that he could not come up with a figure to submit to the Selectmen on how much it would cost the Town to bring the Pennell and Martel Roads up to standards for plowing by the Town before the Article is presented at Town Meeting due to the heavy snow coverage but that the road would have to be made wider and several trees cut down. Easements would be needed from property owners also.

Waterboro Patent Corp To be called and requested that they submit a list of personal property to the Assessor's on or before April 1st. The Corp. office worker had called and requested that the operation be reassessed as most of the equipment is being dismantled and removed.

GAI: Tax Collector given the go ahead to collect back taxes on Lake Arrowhead Est. Lots on lien . Lot # 1448, 2137 & 2189.

Articles: Selectmen reviewed all Articles on the Warrant for Annual Town Meeting, March 13th. Several citizens to be sent letters notifying them of the numbers of the Articles they are supporting so that they would have time to prepare to explain their requests.




Abatement: Maragret Marsden, denied.
