

MINUTES

Selectmen's Meeting

March 30, 1982

Present: Andrew Woodsome, Jr. Robert Fay, Jean Chick , Douglas Foglio,
Van Foglio, David Silva.

Information arrived from Garnsey Bros. Agency on coverage for the appointed Constables. One half million coverage, \$250. deductible. Premium \$350. plus 3% surplus tax total \$360.50.

Selectmen signed approximately 60 Foreclosures.

Starret Pierce in to ask about obtaining two lots up in Lake Arrowhead that abutts a small lot owned by him. He owns Map 14 Lot 32 and would like to purchase Map 42 Lot A44 or A45. Both of the lots are on the "Swap Pool" held until Jan/1, 1990 for swapping purposes with GAI.

Bruce Champney in with a bill for materials to install the wells at the Dump transfer site. He is the owner of Yankee Drilling under contract with the Town. The bill was approved. He also asked that the road be made passable to the well sites.

Douglas Foglio in to discuss the escalation clause in his snow plowing contract for the southern section of Town. He will submit a bill for next warrant.

Foglio took a copy of the Ossipee Hill Road plans to decid- if he wants to submit a bit for the work.

The Town Hall was checked out by the Selectmen, Foglio, Silva and Van Foglio. The workmanship is being questioned .Walt Stimpson to be called and asked to check the building out and give the Selectmen a written review of the condition of the old Town House. Woodsome wants in writing what is happenng and what can be done.

Town Dump discussed and Foglio was asked if he would be bidding on the reclaiming of the old dump. Fay said the DEP wanted a 3 to 1 slope but would go along with a 2 to 1 slope. A test pit would have to be dug and clay enough so water will not penetrate. Fay said that DEP said no need to hire a consultant that Don Kale of DEP would work with the Town on the project.

David Silva in with a list of property owners that had received building permits as of April, 1981. He had checked each for the percentage of completion.

Roger Elliott to be called to draft up a deed conveying the Map 15 Lot 9 over to James Foss as per Article 66 at the Annual Town Meeting. Also he will be asked his opinion on the fact that Northeast Bank has foreclosed on Edgar Garland owner of Westwinds Subdivision would Northeast Bank now be responsible for the road repairs within the subdivision.
