Meeting opened by Chmn. Monteith. Monteith said that he had received calls from SAD Directors Willett and Lord. Monteith said the Board of Selectmen had signed for the Engineer to get a proposal ready for the reclaiming of the old Town Dump. And the bid would go out the middle of May. Ossipee Hill Road project would be the same specs. as last year. He said the Contractor last year told the Board that he would do the project for the same price as last year. However there are others that would like to look the project over and possibly bid. Project should be completed by Sept. 1st.

As of May 1st. the C.E.O., Building & Plumbing Inspectors jobs will be combine. Mr. Foglio to take over the appointment.


Picnic Area on Rte. 5 discussed at length. An Article to go on the Warrant at Special Town Mtg. to raise monies for toilets and fencing.
