Concealed weapons permit issued to Frank E. Carll.

Moto-Cross Licenses signed for June 19 & 20th.

Inquiry made by Greg Carroll of the Elechers Neck Lobster Pound in Biddeford Pool as to whether a permit was needed to have a fish truck parked in Waterboro to sell Lobsters, etc. Selectmen said Town does not have an Ordinance against this. Mr. Carroll will be called and informed of this.

Perley Yeaton, Sr. in to talk to the Selectmen concerning the transfer of his property from Tree Growth to Mr. Yeaton had been sent the proposed penalty and asked that he contact the Selectmen before the property was taken out of tree growth. Mr. Yeaton stated that he did want the parcel removed from tree growth and agreed to pay the penalty when the 1982 tax bills are sent. The penalty will be in the form of a supplement billing.

Roger Elliott will be sent the material on Town owned lot 1352 in Lake Arrowhead for the lot to be conveyed to John B. Shea, No. Waterboro. The lot has been paid for and the \$40. deed preparation fee.

The vote was unanimous that the Tax Collectors and Selectmen's offices be closed in order that the Clerk and her deputy can go to the Registry of Deeds to research for liens.

The State Bureau of Taxation Formula will be used to assess the boats and watercraft in the Town of Waterboro for 1982.

Abatement to be signed for the 1980 personal tax on Howard Doe (Howies Donut Shop) of \$97.50.


Selectmen Woodsome and Fay reported the following:

Meeting held at the new stump dump with Glenn Bean, Rd. Comm.

Bean agreed to clear area of stump dump to meet the State Forestry Code, build a drive around stump dump area for an extra \$800. over the original \$2,000. bid.

Bean also discussed the Bennett Hill Rd. with the two Selectmen, From the old Town dump to the new Town dump Bean said to grub and clear and surface \$12,000., plus the TRI monies of \$2,600.
