Glenn Bean: In with payroll and did not present a Plan, as he said he had plenty of work to last until next Tuesday. Fay suggested that he take a look at the brush along the sides of the road in by Ken Roberts in No. Waterboro, also to look at the Knight's road as it comes onto the Ossipee Hill road and slopes off. Fay said he felt when the grader is being used to ditch the side of roads that it tends to slope the sides to much. Woodsome suggested that they may want to try a larger piece of equipment to do the ditching.

Starr King: Mr. King met with the Selectmen and Road Commissioner to discuss the turnaround on the Middle road. Mr. King's land is now being used and the trucks are cutting in. King wants to change the turnaround North of King's property about 500', North to a woods road. Selectman Fay, King and snow plowing Contractor Foglio have met prior to tonight's meeting and discussed making a more satisfying turnaround and parking area for snowmobilers and hunters.

1982 Tax Rate set for \$14.90 per thousand. Bills to be mailed out as soon as possible.



Two licenses for Moto Cross racing signed for Sept. 5 & 6, 1982.
