SELECTMEN'S MEETING

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Jean Chick, Debbie Hardy of the Tribune, Glenn Bean Rd. Comm.

Lot 1761 Lake Arrowhead Est. G.A.I. had called to ask if the back taxes could be paid on the lot. Selectmen voted not to accept taxes until the Town receives the deed from Peter Plumb's office, with this lot on it.

Walt Stinson had called the office to notify the Selectmen that Nancy Norman of the D.E.P. would be sending a letter of approval for the Reclaiming of the Landfill.

Two Gun permits signed, Joseph Pozsette and Derrill McPherson.

Peter Hanson Contractor for the Reclaiming of the Landfill will be sent a letter on the Agreement made that he would use the available loam that the Town had, as it does not reflect on the Sept. 13th bill received.

Bid accepted on Lot 1487 for \$500.00 from Anthony Colonnese. Letter of acceptance to be sent.

Rec'd a check for \$598.00 from Rev. Richard Weisenbach for lot 1662 will send a letter informin Weisenbach that a deed for lot 1662 will be drawn up when the Town receives final payment of \$1,000. for the lot.

BMX race licence signed. No fee.

Several Abatement were worked on.

Fire Station to Pound Hill 2,945' /

Top of new piece on Ossipee Hill Rd. to top of hill 1,428'

East Shore Road 3,365'.

Roberts Ridge Rd. from the pole line to Jim Benson's farm 2,633'.

Middle Rd. from Kenneth Roberts to end of tar 3,534'.


Hamilton Road from Rte.202 to Hamilton's Steel Hut. 4,089'.
