Selectmen's Meeting

An interested party had inquired about the snow plowing status of old Town roads, such as the Mansion road and the Johnson road. Selectmen said these two roads were on the list going before a public hearing for discontinuance.

It was noted that the Town Offices would be closed tomorrow as the Town Clerk and Deputy Clerk would be attending classes in Portland.

In payment for the use of the old Town dump, Dorothy Wakefield will receive payment of \$900.00 for nine month period the dump site was used. Voted unanimously. The site has since been re-claimed and has D.E.P. approval.

It was brought to the Selectmen's attention that the building on Map 17 Lot 17, belonging to Guy Dixon of Gorham, had been left off the tax run-off since the revaluation in 1980. The Tax Collector had sent him a supplemental billing for 1982 taxes on the building assessment. Selectmen voted unanimously to also supplement for the 1980 and 1981 tax on the building assessment.


Several abatements signed.


Town Accounts discussed. Several adjustments were made.
