Minutes - Regular Meeting - December 14, 1982.

Present: John C. Monteith, Chmn, Andrew C. Woodsome, Jr.
and Robert C. Fay. Dianne Holden, Town Clerk/Tax Coll/
Treas. also present.

Victualer's licensing hearing held at 7:30 pm for the
Eye Opener Coffee Shop, Avis Atkinson, Prop. License
unanimously approved. Town Clerk to issue license.

The Board of Selectmen submitted a partial budget to the
Finance Committee for their review.

The Board of Selectmen voted to recommend that all recre-
ational budget requests be submitted together under the
Parks and Recreation Commission. Thomas Costello, Pres.
of the Youth League and Eric Christensen, Chmn. of the
Parks & Rec. Commission will be so notified.

The Town Clerk was instructed to contact Atkinson Electric
for the installation of three yard lights. Also to have
them check out the light at the ball field on the Old Alfred
Road and the outlets around the stage area in the Town Hall.

John Chenard's son of Lakewood Drive is working on a Boy
Scout badge for which he has to donate 6 hours of his
time to the community. The Selectmen asked him to do
6 hours of shoveling snow this winter. He agreed.

John McGlincy of Nor'east Printing was in in regards to
the Annual Report. The Clerk was asked to contact the
Historical Society for their suggestions for the cover.
It was decided to dedicate the report to F. Robert Fay.
Mr. McGlincy requests that a 50% deposit be mailed to
him Jan. 1, 1983. The Selectmen agreed.

Andrea Boland, researcher at the York County Registry of
Deeds office was in. The Selectmen agreed to hire her at
the rate of \$10.00 per hour to research so-called unknown
owners of lots in the Town. Mrs. Boland is to research
the John Sinclair lot located on Clarks Bridge Rd. first.

Road Commissioner Glenn Bean submitted payroll. He was
instructed to order culverts for next years use. He also
submitted road account figures for the 1983 budget.

Michael Hammond was in to talk with the Selectmen about
reactivating the Charter Commission. After discussion,
the Board agreed to have nomination papers made available
for the election of 6 members at the 1983 Annual Town Meeting.

The York County Commissioners requested the Assessor pro-
vide them with valuation figures of other comparable land
with no road frontage in the Town in regards to the abate-

ment appeal on Southern Maine Realty Trust (Buff Brook Estates). The Selectmen drafted a letter for the Clerk to type and a copy of which is on file in their office.

The Selectmen announced that they would not be meeting on Tues., Dec. 21st. due to the holiday. The Clerk is to so notify the papers.

The Board acted on a general assistance request.



The Board signed abatements #55-82 through 62-82.
