Selectmen's Meeting, Jan. 4, 1983

Mrs. Harold Williams owner of the Trailer located at Map 55, Lot 23, Twin Pines Trailer Park in to talk with the Selectmen concerning payment of back taxes. Woodsome explained that the Town had to collect the 1979 taxes and have the lein discharged before taking payment on the 1980, 1981 & 1982 taxes. Williams owes a \$44.80 balance for 1979 plus 89.02 interest and 53.00 for deed preparation. She was informed that the Town could take the trailer and auction it off, as they did property in August. If the 1980 taxes are not paid by 3/3/83 the Williams will be faced with another foreclosure. Mrs. Williams is concerned about a notice she received from the bank that holds her mortgage pressing her to get the taxes paid.

Alan Dyer issued a weapon permit.

Workmen's Comp. Insurance discussed. The Insurance Company to be called and questioned about the amounts (money figures) used to set the price.


