Daniel J. Bauer-Conley appointed to the Conservation Comm. to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Cindy Frost. Appointment to last until April of 1984.

Revenue Sharing Hearing held at the Finance Committee Meeting, 6 members of the committee, Selectman Monteith and Jean Chick in attendance. Voted to pass. No objections either oral or written were given.

Letter to be sent to Attorney Roger Elliott to request that he represent the Town for the ensuing year.

Mrs. Edward O'Neill, O.O. Beach was called by Woodsome in regards to the assessment on her boats. The Assessment was explained and Mrs. O'Neill said that the 18 house power motor on the 1964 Craftsman did not exist. Woodsome explained that the Town went solely on the computer run-off from the State which listed the motor on it. O'Neill will be called tomorrow with the total tax due including the interest and call the State on the problem with the motor.

Robert Abbott: Snow Plowing Contractor for the North Section of Town in to discuss the plowing of Eon Way. Dan Willett, former Selectmen was called in from the Finance Committee meeting to confirm that the Selectmen did not plow the section of Eon Way after 1973 because of the fence erected on the Cote property and the Garage built, the also had been built up at that time adding to the difficulty of plowing. Selectmen agreed to pay Abbott an additional \$200.00 to go down in to the Dube property.

Abbott said that he also would plow the new Stump Dump for additional monies. Selectmen agreed to pay Abbott \$300.00 to plow from the Transfer STation to the Stump Dump. Abbott said he would need a key to get into the dump area. Richard Stevens will be called for copies of the key for Abbott and the Fire Dept.


