Meeting opened by Chairman Monteith, reported that the Auditor was working in the office on the Town books. Town Report being readied. Also that the Finance Committee is meeting each week on the 1983 budget requests, making their recommendations for Town Meeting. Monteith also announced that the Charter Commission would be reactivated this year with papers available for the office in the Town Clerk's office. He said several had taken out papers for the office of Selectman, Road Commissioner and School Director.

Monteith said that the Town sold 22 sets of the Ossipee Hill Rd., reconstruction Specs. and received 16 bids , which were opened at tonight's Selectmen's Meeting. The bid was not awarded, but the bids received would give the Selectmen a money figure to go into Town Meeting with.

Monteith said that the Town needed the tax anticipation monies the first of the year, therefore, monies borrowed for 6.8%, perhaps a little higher than if they could have waited. 1982 monies did not cost the Town much in interest because of the re-investing.

Monteith is working trying to get a new legislative district with possibly the Town's of Waterboro, Alfred and Lyman.

Tax Collector Holden said that at the end of the year she had collected 78% of 1982 taxes. Discussion held on the Town billing twice a year on real estate taxes. Ken Corthell and Elizabeth Gould were in favor of twice a year billing.


Industrial Comm: Willis Lord Chairman of the Commission said that the State Rep. would be meeting with the commission on Feb. 10th. and he would have more to report next month.


Planning Board: Roland Denby, Chairman reported that the Board was shot one member and that two of their members terms would be running out this April. Denby said that the Zoning Ordinance Revisions were being typed and copies made, 28 pages in all and that public hearing would be held. Denby said the Board may ask the Waterborough Historical Soc. to come up with a list of names to give to subdividers for names of roads.

ZBA: Nothing to report.

SAD#57: Director Lord reported on the upcoming meeting to be held in each Town on Feb. 15th. when voting on swapping monies from accounts would be decided on. Lord said that he hoped people would attend the budget meeting this year as the Board needed the input. The budget will be much higher this year. Discussion held on the additions needed at the high school and also the possibilities of going to double sessions in the near future. Lord said with the planned trailer park in Alfred and the new developments in Lyman that the schools in those two towns would be over crowded. Also the Board is discussing a Starter school in Limerick.
