Jan. 25, 1983

Regular Meeting, Board of Selectmen

Present: Chmn. John Monteith, Andrew Woodsome, Jr, Robert Fay,

Walter Stinson: In to review with the Selectmen the bids received on the Phase II, Reconstruction of the Ossipee Hill Road. Walt estimated the ledge at the turn and top of the project to be 1,361 yards, he said on Option IIA the Foglio bid looked good. If Option IIB, not removing so much ledge then W.L. Sturgeon looks good. Woodsome asked if anything had been left out of the bid specs., that would surprise them later, Stinson said no. Specs include the completed piece of road, tarring, loaming the sides, gravel etc., Stinson said he did have a plan for cutting slopes that he would send down. and that the Town would have to purchase some land. Woodsome asked if anything else should be brought up and Stinson said no, that he had looked for any disclaimers (changes on specs). He said Foglio had made a note that ledge would not go over \$5,000.

Selectman Fay asked if Stinson thought the Board should have the top (lowest) bidders of Option IIA come in next Tuesday, with Stinson present and go over their bids and perhaps be able to save the Town some money, possibly on the gravel and loam at the Town Stump Dump Site. It was agreed that P.Y. Estes & Son, W.L. Sturgeon, Stuart, Torno & Stuart and Douglas Foglio come in. Letters to go out with the specific times allotted to the companies, starting at 7:30 P.M.

Stump Dump: The Stump Dump work will be going out to bid this year, bids to be opened Feb. 8th. Glenn Bean said that a lot of the rubbish being dumped there should be going into the compacter and not the Stump Dump. The gravel on the new four acre parcel the Town has was discussed. It may be possible to use some of the gravel on the Ossipee Hill Road Project.

Douglas Foglio: In to ask the Selectmen to please have the Road Comm. make a turnaround on Andrew's Lane so that he can get turned around once he has plowed snow up into the Lane. Rd. Comm. had left the meeting he will receive a letter on this.

Foglio also brought in a copy of the SAD# 57 snow plowing Contract for 1983-84 winter. A copy of the Contract was made for the Selectmen's files. Included in the contract is the sanding of the school yard. The Town has always in the past sanded the yard, the school will be notified next year that the town will no longer be responsible for sanding as the job has gone out to bid.

Requests: The Town Committees have made a request that a mail slot be installed in one of the office doors so that they may be able to slide paper work into the offices on off hours. Selectmen agreed to have this done.
