Ossipee Hill Road Construction:

Estes & Sons: Steve Estes called Selectman Fay on the telephone to inform him that the company would have to maintain the price they originally bid to meet the specs.

Stuart, Torno & Stuart Co.: Chalres Torno in with a written Revised Bid, as follows: Original bid (1600 ft. @ \$32.95/ft) \$52,714.90. Discount on original bid \$10,000.00. Estimated cost of addition of approx. 1460 ft., \$26,728.00, estimated total cost \$69,442.90 (approx. 3060 ft @ \$22.69/ft). Note: Estimate does not include cost of guard rail and culvert extensions.

W.L. Strugeon Co.: Mr. Day in with a written proposal on changes in the profiles on finish grade to cut 2770 from the original 5092 equaling 2322 @ 2.00 = \$4,644.00.

Douglas Foglio in at 9:45 with a letter contents as follows: As requested this letter confirms our on site inspection of Sat., last as what I would do with the extra spoil from the Ossipee Hill Road job. If less than 500 yards ledge, no ledge cost.

Stump Dump Bids:

Glenn Bean Sr. Bid read as follows: Through the months of April and November I will burn when conditions permit and push over and cover debris to be pushed at least every two weeks as needed. \$3,000.00.

Dwayne Woodsome: Bid read as follows: I Dwayne Woodsome do submit a bid to push back and burn the Town Stump Dump for \$140.00 based on pushing it only once every 2 weeks. This will be burned when burning permit can be obtained. If dump needs additional pushing, it will be done at \$55.00 a push.

The payments to be made monthly at \$140.00. Any additional materials (large stumps, etc.) that need to be burned, will be taken care of with the price being negotiated, all permits being taken care of by the Town of Waterboro.

Douglas Foglio: Bid submitted at 9:45 as follows: Per hour- 350 SD \$30.00; 450 SD \$35.00; D4D Cat \$38.00; D6D Cat \$50.00; 55III A Mich \$40.00. Total yearly price \$2,550.00.

William A. Parker, Saco, Me: Re.1980 taxes on Lot 36B, Map 11. No decision made on Mr.Parker's question on abating the interest and fees on this as the original bill had been sent to another William A. Parker of East Waterboro, by mistake in 1980 and the owner of record did not receive a billing. Selectman Fay said he would bring the matter up to a vote if one of the other Selectmen appeared at tonights meeting or Mr. Parker could come in next week. Chmn.Monteith attended later in the evening and it was voted to abate the interest figure of \$19.59. Mr. Parker will be telephoned and informed of this decision.

Mr. & Mrs. Howard Merrill: In to discuss the snow plowing of Andrew's Lane. The Merrill's have purchased the Elizabeth Corcoran property. Fay explained that the plow does go up to the Moody Pond road and the area not being wide enough to turn a big truck around, that being the reason that a small pick up was used to plow. Merrill said that they did not own the property that would have to be used to make the turn around that a John K erry of Old Orchard Beach was the owner, therefore when Rd.Comm. Bean was up and discussed this matter with them, they felt that Bean would contact Kerry to get his approval. The Merrill's would like assurance that the road will be plowed each storm.
