Discussion held on the maintenance of the IBM typewriters and office calculators. Several companies will be called for prices. Also at that time a price of paper for the copier machine will be requested.

Jaycee Women have requested table space at Annual Town Meeting. Selectmen voted to let them set up out in the lunch room area.

Researcher Andrea Boland will be written a letter asking that she submit a report and bill for the work done on Map 15 Lot 5. Which has been listed as unknown for years and that Donald Johnson Trustee for Johnson Lumber Co. will be asked if he knows the ownership of the parcel.

The Amendment to the Cable Television Franchise agreement was signed by Monteith and Woodsome.

COUNCIL MEETING

Brian Chernack, invited to speak on the Block Grants available to the towns in York County. After explaining the procedure of the application, etc. if it was decided that it was too late for the town to apply at this time, that this would have to wait for another year. Applications are due in March 3, 1983 and the application being very lengthy and also would have to have some true commitments, it would be impossible to meet the deadline.

State Planning Grants are available for the next six months which need a 25% match in funds, minimum \$5,000. proposals issued in July, not too many communities are ready for this year.

Chernack said that he would keep the Committee posted and be of any help that he could in filling out and filing the application for the Town. If the Town wanted to go for a Grant to be used at the Waterboro Patent Corp. then the Town should have a written commitment from Mr. Alan Zion.

Constable Waterhouse delivered the results of the Waterboro vote for the SAD #57 transfer of funds in the budget, 111 yes, 130 no. Monteith said that the school budget meeting were being held and were open to the public. The proposed budget for this year is 5¼ million, up 400,000. over last year a 9.8 increase.


