1. Municipal activities shall be ^{given} first consideration in use of the hall.
2. Wedding Receptions, Anniversary Parties, Non-profit Organizations, Rental Fee: \$20.00. The Selectmen reserve the right to waive payment of fees.
3. Private Parties, applicant must meet with the Board of Selectmen to review their application. Rental Fee: \$50.00. At least one Law Enforcement Officer/Constable, must be present. The Board of Selectmen reserve the right to require additional law enforcement.
4. The Selectmen reserve the right to waive the payment of fees, for any private groups/citizens, raising funds for legitimate causes.
