MINUTES

Present: Chmn. Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Jean Chick, Gleen Bean, Sr.

Maine Municipal Assoc.: Requesting that the Municipal Officers vote for the enactment to increase the Maine Revenue Sharing Program to be funded in part through the meals and lodging tax set at 7%, in order to result in additional State Revenue Sharing to the Towns. Ruth Ham, Selectman of Shapleigh called and talked with Selectmen Fay and asked that the Waterboro Board of Selectmen vote on this tonight at their meeting. The matter was discussed and a vote taken to not sign in favor of the increase.

Mark Caldwell: Mark was called and asked to meet with the Board on Monday at 7:30 pm. to assist them in assessing.

Roger Braley: Rep. of Y.C.C.A.C. had talked with Selectman Woodsome during the day and asked permission from the Board for use of one of the rooms in the Town Hall for an Agent from any of the York County Agencies to work out of to assist the area people in obtaining help through the several programs available. The Board voted in favor of letting them have the use of the room.

Steven Marchessault: Mr. Marchessault had inquired about the washout of his drive way on Mountain View Subdivision. Selectmen Abbott asked that a letter be sent to Marchessault informing him that the matter was being investigated.

Stump Dump: The Stump Dump to go out to bid again. Notice will be placed in the Journal Tribune. Bids to be in the Town Office on May 3, 1983 at 7:00 pm. Specs will be available at the Selectmen's Office.

John Brock: Brock in to see the Building Inspector was asked to meet with the Board of Selectmen regarding his interests in the Waterboro Patent Corp. property in So. Waterboro. Word have spread to Selectman Fay that the D.E.P. had given a prospective client of Brock's some possibly misinformation on the conditions of the property. Fay had telephoned the office of D.E.P. and talked with a Neil Aho concerning this matter. Aho denied any knowledge of any one telling anyone that phoned that the property in So. Waterboro was a death trap and that it would be best that the client stayed away from the buying into any deal.

Brock said that he had had three good prospects. One person called the D.E.P. and was told that there were deep injection wells on the property and also a Bunker C Tank that should have been dug up and never had been. Brock said that he had inquired about this and had been told that the Bunker C Tank had been leaking, was emptied and a new tank installed at the same time. As for the deep injection wells no one seems aware that they ever existed. D.E.P. was called by Brock and he was told that the site that they had files on was the lagoon area in East Waterboro. Brock contacted Pat Demers to have a water test done and Demers advised Brock to wait and see what materials he should be testing for.

Woodsome said that he wanted to have a letter in the office from D.E.P. stating that the property had a clean bill of health. Also wants the name of the person making statements about the wells, tanks, etc.

Brock will try to get the name from the client and get back to the Town. Brock asked that the Town wait a few days and let him find out just what was taking place. Problem may be solved and not to get the D.E.P. upset.

Woodsome said that in time he wanted a letter to go out of this office to the Hazardous Waste Disposal Dept. of D.E.P. and an answer from them that the property in So. Waterboro was safe.

Brock will get back to the Town on any information he can obtain in regards to the matter.
