

## MINUTES

May 10, 1983  
Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean, Sr., Jean Chick, Dianne Holden.

### Ossipee Hill Road:

Chmn. Woodsome reported that he had received a phone call from Robert Freeman, property owner on Ossipee Hill road an abutter to the section of road that is to be reconstructed. Freeman told Woodsome that he was in favor of repairs and if he could help out to call him, but that he would not be able to attend the May 7th. meeting at the site.

Selectmen Abbott said that he attended the on-site meeting and that Town Engineer Walt Stinson gave a good explanation of the intended construction. There seemed to be little problem with the abutters there, only that the Collin's wanted the wood from the trees that need to be cut on their property and that Mr. Kelly wants the Selectmen to sign a paper that the stonewall on his property will be placed back as it is now. Abbott said he would not be willing to sign such a letter.

Tax Collector asked if the Selectmen would give their authority for her to collect back taxes from David Daudelin on his lots at Lake Arrowhead Estates. Selectmen agreed that the taxes can be taken and the liens lifted.

Town Clerk asked if the Selectmen wished to have the Alternate Ballot Clerks to come in to count next Tuesday for the SAD #57 Budget vote. Selectmen voted to hire them to come in.

Chmn. Woodsome telephoned John Woodman to ask if Woodman had the name of the person that would serve the Town as Health Officer. Woodman gave the name of Ellie McCarty. Papers will be made out and Ms. McCarty contacted at the Limerick Office.

Stump Dump/Transfer Station: Richmond Stevens, Contractor and Howard Stone Attendant were invited in to discuss the hours and dumping of goods at the Stump Dump. An Agreement has been made with Glenn Bean, Sr. to maintain the stump dump for a year and Mr. Stevens admitted that it is his duty to see that the attendant directs all dumpers to the stump dump. A sign will be erected at the dump for placement of the different materials such as Woody debris, white goods, tires, etc.

Glenn Bean submitted several articles he found in the stump dump that should have been dumped at the compactor. A letter will be sent to Robert Boutet informing him that the material found belonged to him and that it should have been placed in the compactor.

A lengthy discussion was held on the dump hours and it was decided to set new hours, 27 hours in all, Sat. 8 am. to 5 pm.; Sun. 10 am. to 5 pm.; Mon. 8 am. to 12 Noon; Wed. 12 Noon to 7 pm. If it becomes necessary for local Contractors to use the Stump Dump/Transfer Station other than the above hours, the Dump Attendant would have to be paid by the Contractor using the Dump. A fee was not set at this time. Mr. Stone said that he would try his best to help Bean keep the Stump Dump in order. New Dump hours will be advertised in the Budget Saver Press, as in the past.

Rd. Commissioner: Bean submitted a proposal for monies to be raised at a Special Town Meeting. A Finance Committee will be called for May 24th. In the mean time Bean will talk to Mr. Bates of Callahan Bros. Co. and ask for an estimated cost to finish construction of about 900 ft. of road to connect the work the Company is doing at Ledgemere Bridge and where the tar road begins. This amount to be presented to the Finance Committee along with the Roads and Bridges requests.



Bean said that he would check in to the matter.


