

MINUTES

May 17, 1983 Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott,
Glenn Bean Rd. Comm. Jean Chick, Secy.

Roads: Rd. Comm. Bean reported that he had spoken with Mr. Sylvester from Alfred concerning the road damage done to the Ossipee Hill Rd., by his logging machinery. Mr. Sylvester assured Bean that the road would be repaired by Sylvester after his logging was completed.

Bean submitted a letter from the Callahan Bros. Construction Company with figures on the amount it would cost to reconstruct the approach on the New Dam road by Ledgemere Bridge. \$7,350.00 for a 12" of road gravel for a paved width of 22 ft., for a length of approx. 960 ft. Also some miscellaneous grubbing. Bean said he felt that he could do the job for less money.

Special Town Meeting: Date set for June 7, 1983 at 7:00 pm. Selectman Fay said that he felt that this should be a Road Commissioner Town Meeting and not a Selectmen's, therefore, Bean should write the Articles, go before the Finance Committee on May 24th. and also present his proposal at the Town Meeting. The other two Selectmen agreed with Fay. However, the Article for the \$12,500. for monies to have gravel crushed at the Town Dump site will be written to give the Selectmen the authority to take the monies out of Unappropriated Surplus.

Stump Dump Agreement: The Agreement was signed by Glenn Bean, Sr. as Contractor, with Andrew Woodsome signing for the Town of Waterboro.

John Hamel: Selectmen were reminded about the upcoming hearing at the York County Commissioners' Court on the John Hamel Abatement denial.


Selectmen gave their approval for the Clark Assos. to purchase the taxpayers listing and addresses from the Computer Center in Falmouth.
