Selectmen's Meeting July 12, 1983

Present: Chmn. Andrew Woodsome, Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Glenn Bean, Dianne Holden, Jean Chick.

Ossipee Lake, Rte. 5: In the last week there has been some controversy about the large rocks place along the shore of the Lake by Mrs. Bertha Smith, abutting land owner, by the culvert and also some buoys place out into the water by Mrs. Smith.

The Selectmen when into an excutive session to discuss several matters before meeting with the public that had come in to complain about the lake situation.

Members of the public present were: Mr. & Mrs. Thomas Blackburn, Anita Drisko, Anthony Molodozen, Dana Blackburn, Mr. & Mrs. Ernest Milhot.

Dana Blackburn said that he was attending the meeting for basically two reasons , one that he felt that he was loosing business, as costumers were always able to dock their boats and walkto his store, second reason being that he felt the Town was loosing another Town right- of- way.

All the Selectmen agreed that Mrs. Smith had made sure she was the property owner and had been given permission from the Game Warden before placing the buoys in the water.

A lenghtly discussion was held by all in attendance. Selectman Abbott said that he had gone to visit with Mrs. Smith after receiving a call from her and that he could sympathize with her after hearing from her the many things she has put up with in the past from the public using the property, for swimming, etc.

It was an unanimous decision of the Board that the Board would visit with Mrs. Smith before making any definite decision as to the Town's involvement in this matter. Public attending the meeting said they would go along with this, but would appreciate an answer from the Board.

At this time Selectman Fay announced the fact that the office had received several complaints of drinking in public and pot smoking at the Town owned Picnic Area on Rte. 5. He said he felt there was not enough law enforcement. Also he feels that the situation must be curbed before asking for money at Town meeting for recreational development ineither the Picnic Area or the Webber property.

Rd. Comm: In with payroll. Will pick up the Town Stump Dump signs in the morning.

Tax Collector: Dianne given permission to collect the back taxes from Alfred & Gertrude Hall L.A. Lots A434 & A435, 1980, 81 & 82.

SAD #57: Chmn. Willis Lord will be sent a letter requesting that the Directors for SAD #57 notify the Selectmen's office if there is a vacancy on the Board. Director Jane Willett is planning to move to a new home in Gorham, Maine.

Building Code: Town Clerk Dianne Holden notified the Board of Selectmen that when Mrs. Lesley Hammond typed the Building Code for the Town that the section pertaining to fences was left out. Mrs. Holden said she would type up a paper and attach it to all the Building Code booklets available but could not be sure of how many books had been given out with this section missing.'

Selectmen were in total agreement to tax the St Matthew's Church in Limerick for the lot that was deeded to them in Lake Arrowhead. Map 44 Lot A400.
