Gordon Carpenter: In to go over the Town maps and advise the Selectmen of several errors in the A.B. & R.B. Carpenter lots.



Doug Foglio, Contractor: In to talk with the Board concerning the Ossipee Hill Rd. reconstruction. Selectmen Fay reported that, taking hoe down both sides of the hill toward the Kelley property to about beside the first house on the right. Foglio will give the Town a price. Fay thinks that this should be done. An additional 44' X 15" culvert would be needed at an estimated price of \$300.00. Also the contour of the driveway to the Sylvia Riely Collins property was discussed and Mrs. Collins was called on the phone by Selectman Fay. Going into the Collins yard and using the easement of the old town road that is discontinued back 20 ft. and lowering the slope 7 to 5 feet. This would make the driveway width 14 to 16 ft. Mrs. Collins was agreeable.

Question asked whether or not the Comm. will remain active for the remainder of the year.
