Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Andrew Woodsome,Jr., Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott,

Rd.Commissioner: Glenn Bean in to talk to the Board about his requests for road accounts at Annual Town Meeting. Bean will get the Finance Comm. request sheet made out and will attend the Finance Comm. meeting on Nov.29th. at 8:30.

Finance Committee: Requests that the Board of Selectmen add more Articles at Annual Town Meeting to take some of the monies from the now mounting Incidentals Account. This would add a Article for the Computer Center expenditures, An account for the salaries of Janitor, Ballot clerks, etc. Also the Committee requests that all office supplies be taken out of the Office Equipment & Maintenance account.

The Board agreed that the Incidental Account is getting high and that they would take the Finance Committees recommendation on splitting up the account.

Nov.29,1983: 7:00 PM. Mr.Leon Bien Vice President of the Money Center of Canal Nat'l. Bank will meet with the Board to discuss the 1984 Tax Anticipation borrowing. 8:30 PM. Atty. Roger Elliott will meet with the Board to discuss the Lake Arrowhead "Swap Pool" lots.

Donald Horton: Owner of the Horton's Doweast Foods, Inc. to discuss the assessments on his property located on Grist Mill Rd. On the Commercial lot with building presently being assessed for \$64,610. upon request from the Waterboro Industrial Commission the Board of Selectmen voted to give Horton a 50% abatement of the 1983 taxes. Next year they will have a certified Assessor recheck the building for a new assessment. This abatement was given on Map 21 Lot 26A.

Turnaround: Selectman Fay said that Mike Hickey would pay for the work on a turnaround on his road if the Town would furnish the gravel. Dwayne Woodsome was asked to get in touch with snow plow Contract Robert Abbott to find out just what needs to be done for work.

Articles Annual Town Meeting: The Board voted on two Articles for the Waterboro Annual Town Meeting. #1 changing the Board of Selectmen to a five member Board. #2 Changing the term of Road Commissioner to a three year term. Vote of the Board was 2 to 1, that these two articles will be on the Town House floor.

Parks & Rec.Comm.: The Board approved the request received from the Commission to man a food sale table at the Annual Town Meeting on March 10th,1984.

Stump Dump: The bid for maintenance of the Stump Dump will go out to bid again this year. Bids to be in by Jan.10,1984. Work to comence on May 1,1984. for a twelve month period.

Renald Ruel: C.E.O. Van Foglio will send Mr. Ruel a letter and have him come in to meet with the Board of Selectmen concerning the cutting of trees on his property on the shore of Ossipee Lake. Mr.Ruel owns Map 35 Lot 14A.

Thanksgiving Baskets: Several Thanksgiving Baskets were received to be distributed to needy families in Town. The Girls Scout Troops, Cub Scouts, Jaycee Women,GTE Products,Inc. were the donors.

D.O.T.,State of MAine: Notification received from the State that Old Alfred Rd. would become a State Highway.West Rd., Goodwins Mills Rd & West Buxton Rd. were not accepted as they failed to meet the State of Maine criteria. A letter will go to the D.O.T. requesting the criteria these Highways did not meet to be classified as a State Highway.
