Feb.21,1984, Selectmen's Meeting.

Jaycee Women: Cherie Taylor and Carole Sylvester representing the group came in to ask the Board if they could install a 3'X3'X12" display case in the upstairs conference room where the group hold their monthly meetings. 
SAD #57: The Board had a lenghtly discussion on severál points concerning the SAD #57 budget with Jon Gale.
