

MINUTES

March 20, 1984

Selectmen's Meeting.

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jean Chick.

Stump Dump: It was decided that the Board should have Richmond Stevens meet with the Board to discuss the chain to be placed across the entrance at the Stump Dump.

Constables: Ed Waterhouse and Chauncey Gerry in to go over the new Dog Ordinance enacted at Annual Town Meeting, March 10th. Waterhouse will contact Ida Mallory to set up a Rabies Clinic, after which the Constables will start enforcing the Ordinance by visiting each home and giving a verbal warning and issuing paper work to each person in violation of the Ordinance.

Hearing Pericorn Rest. License to serve Malt & Wine requested by owners Grace and Carmine DeSimone. Abbott made the motion to issue the license, Fay seconded the motion. License was signed by the Board and witnessed by Jean Chick.

Mr. & Mrs. James Seward: In to question conditions of the Bagley Road. The Seward's were at Annual Town Meeting when an Article that had been submitted by the Smith's owners of property on the Bagley Road that \$6,000. be raised was defeated. The Seward's said they would be willing to place a culvert and some gravel at their own expense on the Bagley road. Selectmen said that as long as the work was done under the direction of the Road Commissioner they could see no harm in the work being done by the Seward's. Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean was called in to meet with the Seward's in the back conference room to discuss the work to be done.

SAD #57: Selectman Woodsome reported that he had spent the day in Augusta in the Legislature discussing the Bill that was before them concerning the SAD Budget. He will return on Friday to continue the case.

Assessor: At Annual Town Meeting \$6,100. was raised in order that the Board hire a Certified Assessor to do some of the assessing for 1984. Mark Caldwell was in to discuss the job with the Board. Mark was hired by the Board and to also do the remapping of the Town for \$600. the \$600. to be taken from the Town Map Account. Mark will get an Agreement written up for the Selectmen and himself to sign. He was told to bring in the wording and that Atty. Elliott would be asked to draw up the necessary contract.

Parks & Recreation: Chairman Eleanor Roberts and Dianne Holden in to report that a meeting being held in the Town Hall at this time they were discussing the structure of the Youth League that the Selectmen had previously gone along with on having Managers and not a President as in the past. Chmn. Fay said that the P&R Comm. could decide that, as long as the P&R had charge of the monies.

Stephen Kasprzak: Mr. Kasprzak at Annual Town Meeting had questioned the "unclassified" breakdown of expenditures. The Auditor has supplied the Town with the breakdown of this account and a copy will be forwarded to Steve, for his review. Steve also questioned the figure on the Assessment committed to the Tax Collector on page 6 of the Town Report the figure is listed as \$903,439.11, should read \$973,439.11, this was a typo error. Mr. Kasprzak asked that these two items be checked out and clarified at the Selectmen's meeting.
