April 17, 1984

Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Jean Chick, Glenn Bean, Rd. Comm.

Town Audit: Letter received from Steve Kasprzak concerning the Town Audit published in the Town Report. The Town Auditor will be called and a meeting date setup for the Auditor and Kanprzak to meet with the Board to explain the "unclassified expenses".

Hamilton Rd: The Road Commission and Selectmen Abbott and Fay met with residents on the Hamilton road concerning the water problems and the placement of culverts. Before making and decisions the Board will call in the Town Engineer Walt Stinson and have him find out the height of culvert at the foot of Hamilton Hill back to Rte.202, also the height from Hamilton road to Rte 202 culvert.

West Rd: The Road Commissioner and Selectmen Abbott and Fay reviewed the problem that the homeowners are having with water laying on thier property (former Everett Brock farm) Selectman Abbott will write a letter to the Dept. of Transportation regarding this matter.

Budget SAD #57: Board discussed the 1984 Budget with Director Willis Lord.

Conservation Commission: Members Dan Langill, Neil Raymond, Debra Downs, Carmine Castaldo, Susan Rose met with the Board to discuss the testing of well water in Town. The Commission was appropriated monies at Town Meeting for the testing. The Board suggested that the testing be done in South Waterboro, East Waterboro and the Old Alfred Road .C.E.O. Van Foglio was asked were he would suggest the tests be done. He said the Leather mill area. D.E.P. seems to test only for bacteria. The bad areas determined by all was the area around Southern Maine Finishing, Corp. East Waterboro, Ricard gravel pit Old Alfred Road, the Leather Mill and the gas problem area on Rte 202 in South Waterboro. Selectman Fay and Foglio suggested the residents of Stanley Ricker. Langill said the Commission had enough money to do 18 tests. Selectman Woodsome told the members to call D.E.P. rep. Fred Brann for any testing that has been done previously and that he felt sure Brann would provide copies requested.

Langill asked if the Town had heard any more about the pending case against So. Maine Finishing by D.E.P. The Board has not. Fay said the Board fully intents to make So. Maine Finishing abide by the newly adopted Hazardous Waste Ordinance. Fay reminded the Commission members of the meeting called for Thursday, April 19th. 7:30 PM. to meet with Atty. McElhinney to review the Ordinance.

Langill asked that the Board also keep the Commission inform of the Housing for the Elderly.
