
Salt Shed: Woodsome said that the building was the Road Commissioners responsibility and if he was not going to have it repaired, as damage has been done to the door and the partition inside, tha the Board of Selectmen would have to have the repair work done. Also Woodsome said that the State's Power Broom had been loaned out to Bean for three weeks and that the State wanted it returned, Bean has not used the Power Broom as yet. Woodsome said that the STate crews would be around in couple of days to start the sweeping the sides of the highways.

LA "Swap Pool" lots: The lots were discussed and it was decided that that Selectman Abbott would work on the listing rather than attend the Council Meeting . This listing is being made up for GAI to deed the necessary lots over to the Town to make up the "Swap Pool" lot listing per Agreement made March, 1979, that the lots be deeded over to the Town and kept for swapping purposes for Contract holders that needed to replace their unbuildable lots at Arrowhead. A deed was never done to convey the lots to the Town , this will bne done as soon as a list is agreed upon. It will be left up to Atty. Elliott's office to set up a date to meet with Atty. Plumb and Elliott to discuss this further.

Council Meeting: In the past few years the Council meeting have bneen canceled out for the months of June, July and August, due to warm weather and Town CCommittee members being out of Town on vacations. Chmn. Fay voted to continue the meeting throuh out the Summer. Selectman Woodsome voted not to hold them, giving the busy time of Assessing as a reason, even through Mark Caldwell has been hired to do most of the work there will be plenty for the Board ot do. Selectman Abbott said that he would like to try a Copuncil meeting in June and see how it goes and then a decision could be made.

Waterboro Patent Corp.: The Town received the deed for the property on Bennett Hill Road that was approved for purchase at the Annual Town Meeting. The Amount of \$27,500. was placed on the EWarrant to pay for the land
