Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay , Rd. Comm. Glenn Bean, Jean Chick.

Dean Waterhouse: In to ask Board to check the legality of the large -rocks placed by Ossipee Lake on the Bertha Smith property. Chmn. Fay informed Waterhouse that the Town had gone through all of this last year when the rocks were placed. Fay said that he was as upset at the time as Waterhouse is now but the Town could do nothing. The Town's Atty. was called M.M.A. and the Dept. of Transportation was also called. The property belongs to Mrs. Smith. Waterhouse wants to know why after so many years of the public being able to use the area Mrs. Smith can all of a sudden close the area off. M.M.A. will be recalled on this tomorrow.


Cold Patch: Chmn. Fay and Rd. Comm. Bean both talked with Thomas Gibson of Commercial Paving Co. regarding their bid for the Mix. Bean agreed to a \$1.75 per yard price for the aggregate and the use of his equipment. Commercial Paving agreed to drop the price by 25¢ to the Town and will start in two weeks. This Bid was accepted by the Board.

Roads: Chmn. Fay asked that Bean cut the bushes along the New Dam Rd. in Arrowhead, by the Clark residence. The sign Company will be called tomorrow for prices of signs requested by citizens. The cost of the signs will not be taken from the Rd. Comm. budget.

Public Hearing: A hearing will be held on June 26th, 7:00 Pm, for the purpose of amending the Zoning Ordinance to allow Elderly Housing in the Town of Waterboro.
