Constables: Chauncey Gerry and Ed Waterhouse in by request of the Board. In the past year the issuance of Dog License has been discussed. Dianne reported that since the publication of the Town Report and the ad placed in the Budget Saver Press that sales of dog liceses has doubled. However, she reported that she has had complaints from citizens asking when the door to door solicitation will be done to collect from those not licenses their dogs. The decision was made for the Constables to start as soon as possible and go door to door.

Chauncey Gerry asked when the Board was going to have the citizen clean up the property on Route 202 in So. Waterboro. Chmn. Fay said this could not be done.

MMA Survey of Municipal Issues: The survey questions were voted on individually and filled out to be sent in to MMA tomorrow. They are on file.


