August 21, 1984            Selectmen's Meeting

Jon Gale: Representing the Board of Directors of SAD #57 came in to meet and discuss with the Board the matter of the Junior High School Principal Douglas Joy sending four out of six of the Town's in the District billings for damaged property or lost books for the 1984 school year in the Junior High School. The Board have since sent back the bills and Mr. Joy has conferred with the Board of Directors at their August 8th. meeting and Mr. Joy was told by a vote of eleven to one to return the bills to the Town of Waterboro Board of Assessor's.

Mr. Gale said that he felt that the School Directors or the Supt. Gallucci should have held a meeting with the Assessor's and not just sent the billing. However, it was noted that the Directors had no knowledge of the bills being sent out until they received a copy of Mr. Fay's letter to Mr. Joy returning the bills.

Selectman Woodsome said that MMA was called for legal advise and was told that the Assessors should have on file in their office written proof that the Directors gave Mr. Joy the authority to send the bills to the Assessors, as by State Law the Board of Directors are to send the bills out.

Selectman Abbott asked if it was the policy of the school to hold back rank cards if the student owes any monies for books or damages.

Gale said yes.

After a lengthy discussion it was decided that the Board of Selectmen would like to see (1) Proof that the parent has been billed for this debt, copies of the bills sent out. (2) Directive from the Board of SAD Directors in writing that they gave Mr. Douglas Joy the authority to send out the bills to the Board of Selectmen, to have in their files in case of parental dispute of the bills.

Mr. Gale was given a copy of the bills received by the Board and a copy of the questions and answers received from Atty. Jackson of MMA.

Food & Craft Table: Board gave permission to the Waterborough Historical Society to have a table at the Nov. 6th. voting.



