Sept. 11, 1984

Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Glenn Bean-Rd. Commissioner; Jean Chick

American Bank: Chmn. Fay asked Selectman Abbott if letters had been sent to area banks asking them to locate in Waterboro. Abbott said he had not as rumor has it that there will never be another bank in the building owned by American Bank. American Bank moved out in May, 1984. The Board would like to see another bank in this building. Chmn. Fay will attempt to find out if the rumor is correct.

Sign: Chmn. Fay asked Selectman Abbott if he was going to paint the sign for the Town Hall. Abbott said he felt that the sign given to him a few years ago is too large. Fay said that perhaps they could get Susan Rose to paint the sign, Abbott would like to get prices from Pine Tree Sign, etc. this matter will be discussed later.

Katie Smith: In concerning placing an Article on the Warrant for Annual Town Meeting to raise monies for the Bagley Road. Chmn. Fay asked if the Smith's had done any work to the road or if they intended to. Mrs. Smith said that they had not as yet done any work. Mrs. Smith wishes to place an Article to read: To see what monies the Town will raise and appropriate for improvement for the Bagley Road. This Article submitted by Mr. & Mrs. Jeffery Smith for \$5,000.00.

Walter Stinson: Selectman Woodsome said Stinson had called him in regards to the Ossipee Hill Road. Woodsome said that the foot cut by the knoll by the Thompason and Brock property, Contractor Stuart, Torno & Stuart says that the base is not suitable and, therefore, extra gravel will be needed, which means more money. Woodsome said they also discuss the drainage on Brock's property. Selectman Abbott at this time questioned the Minutes of the Sept. 4th. meeting of the Selectmen. He reminded the Board that they had voted not to cut any more brush and Brock had asked about.

Section 504, Fed. Rev. Act: Members appointed to the Self Evaluation Team are Jean Chick, Coordinator; Barbara StLouis; Jon Gale; Cynthia Winslow Van Foglio. Members will be notified to come in to be sworn in.

Dump Stickers: As soon as prices are available the stickers will be ordered to go on the inside of the windshield of vehicles.

Closing Roads: Roads to be closed will have signs posted by them with the dates that they will be closed, a list to be put together by Road Commissioner Bean.

Bennett Hill Rd: Chmn. Fay asked if Bean had got any prices on hottopping the area by the Transfer Station, Bean said that he was having a hard time getting any because everyone is busy. Fay asked if Glenn would like the Selectmen's Office to take care of phoning around to the different businesses and Glen said no that he would handle the calling himself.

Gift Lots, LAE: Mr. Fred Bearham had called the office to find out the status of lot 1678. Mr. Bearham would like to purchase this lot. Lot 1678 was accepted at Annual Town Meeting in March 1984. The Board agreed that a list of all gifts of LAE lots be made up and these lots would be

Presented at a Town Meeting for the voter to decide whether or not they should be sold in the same manner as they are being bid on each month at the present time.



Picnic Area: Selectman Woodsome asked that a letter go to the Parks and Recreation Commission to ask that they move the trash barrels over to the Route 5 side of the Area. Boaters are dumping their trash. Also to mention that the Little League field on Old Alfred Road needs to be cleaned up.

Stuart, Torno & Stuart: Representatives Charles Torno and Mark Stuart attended this meeting to discuss their work at Ossipee Hill Rd. Also John Brock resident of the road was present.

Charles Torno said that in the cut area the stuff under neath was not suitable and gravel would be needed for \$3,000. extra. Torno said that also Thompson and Brock wanted all the wall taken down. Chmn. Fay said that the Board had been told that the wall was to stay. Torno said that the abutters had changed thier minds. This work would cost the Town an extra \$3,900. to take the wall and replace it with a barb wire fence. This matter was discussed and the engineered plans viewed. Brock said that he was not an engineer and did not understand the plans, but the finish work looks bad. Rd. Comm. Bean agreed with Brock as did Torno & Stuart.

Wlat Stinson, Town Engineer was called on the phone and asked to meet at Roge's Restaurant in So. Waterboro at 8:30 AM. on Friday Sept. 14th. with the Rd. Comm., Selectmen and Brock, Stuart & Torno to go to the Ossipee Hill Road and review the Project together and discuss what will happen with the extra gravel needed and the wall and fencing.
