Sept. 18, 1984

Selectmen's Meeting.

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Glenn Bean, Rd. Commissioner, Jean Chick, Walt Stinson, Town Engineer.

Tax Rate: Discussed, will wait for final figure from the Computer Center. Possibly be set for \$15.50 per \$1,000.
John McGlincey, Northeast Printing: Mr. McGlincey in to talk to the Board concerning the Town's Dump Sticker. A choice was made to have 2"X2" white stickers with medium blue ink depicting the Town Seal. This sticker could also be used for any use such as the Picnic Area in the future.


Culvert, Webber Rd: A few months ago Mr. Weeks and Mr. Hutchins met with the Board and the Rd. Commissioner and they were promised a culvert. They have not yet received the culvert and have inquired about it. Rd. Comm. Bean said the culvert would be in place within a couple of weeks.

Transfer Station: Rd. Comm. Bean made the suggestion that the Town wait and use a 1,000 yards of tar patch next year. No decision was made at this time.

Ossipee Hill Rd: Property owner Russell Keith is in the process of building a new home. A culvert which Contractor Stuart, Torno & Stuart has installed will have to be moved 20 ft. to a concrete marker by CMP pole #397.

Hamilton Rd. Drainage: The problem of flooding on the Hamilton Rd. and Rte., 202 has been a problem for several years. The Board has hired Town Engineer Stinson to come up with a proposal for Annual Town Meeting in 1985. The residents that would be affected by the flooding had been invited to meet with the Board and Stinson for their views and knowledge, having lived with the situation. Mr. & Mrs. Wendell Hamilton, Sr.; Mr. & Mrs. Wendell Hamilton, Jr., Mr. & Mrs. Dwight Pierce, Roland Pierce and Lucien Boucher was in attendance. After a long discussion on the problems it was decided that at least two things should be tried. 1) to increase the size of the ditch along the Hamilton Road and to place larger culverts. 2) to increase the size of culvert that crosses Route 202 about Wendell Hamilton, Jr. property. If these two things do not solve the problem then the State will be contacted for their help. Stinson told the residents that he would do more work on his survey of the area and get back to them. The Board would like the proposal ready by March, Town Meeting. Selectman Woodsome asked Roland Pierce outright if he (Pierce) would be willing to have the Town put in a ditch across his property as was done years ago, to help alleviate the problem. Pierce answer was No.

Ossipee Hill Rd: Selectmen Abbott and Woodsome met with Stuart, Torno & Stuart in regards to the project while Chairman Fay chaired the Council meeting. The following was agreed upon: (1) Remove stone wall by the Thompson/Brock properties. (2) not plain off any of road grade as stands, widen if necessary. (3) Agreed to move the culvert by Russell Keith property, will bill the Town for labor and machine time.
