

## MINUTES

Oct. 23, 1984      Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Robert Fay, Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Glenn Bean, Jean Chick

Roads: Discussion held with the Rd. Comm. on the roads. Fay asked if the road in by the Robert Bedard property had been graded, Bean said that that road had been missed, also the next road up, Bean will see if he can get them done. Woodsome said some of the roads were left with large rocks, Bean said he hadn't been over the roads as yet. Woodsome said that the East Shore road should be checked out, bad rock problems. Woodsome asked Bean if he had started the winter stockpile, Bean said he had not.

Rd. Comm. Bean said that he had read the notice in the newspaper concerning the installation of poles by Central Maine Power Co. on the Bagley Road he said that one of the poles #15 would cause a problem with maintaining the road. The Board asked that CMP worker Richard Hanson be called and told to get in touch with the Road Commissioner before installing the poles.

A letter received from Mary Hollingshead, property owner on Lone Pond in regards to improvements to the road into the Pond. Rd. Comm. asked that a letter be sent out of this office informing Mrs. Hollingshead that the road is a private road, therefore, not the Town's responsibility.

Westwinds Road conditions discussed, the Rd. Comm. said that before plowing of the roads some gravel should be placed. The Board could not agree on whether or not monies should be spent on the roads, other than the monies raised at Annual Town meeting for plowing. Bean said that the roads need the gravel before plowing and that he had not touched the road as far as maintenance goes for two years.

The land and roads are at present owned by Northeast Bank, each time the Town's Attorney Roger Elliott makes inquiry to the land and road status it appears that the land is in the process of being sold, therefore, the Bank asks that the Town wait and talk to the new owners. Final decision on this matter was to ask the snowplowing Contractor Doug Foglio to meet with the Board next Tuesday evening.

Andrews Lane : Bean said that he had prepared the road for plowing. This will also be discussed with Foglio, the snowplowing Contractor.

Saco River Corridor Comm: Appointments were made, Thomas Cole as regular member and Clarence Woodsome, Jr. as alternate member, each for three years.

Tim Roubo: In to talk with the Board concerning rental of the Town Hall for a Wedding Reception. The fee will be \$20.00 and a Constable to be on duty, hired by Roubo.

Swap Pool: Chairman Fay will write a letter to Atty. Elliott to have him start proceedings regarding the deed, etc. to these lots.

Agricultural Stabilization & Conservation Service: The Board of Selectmen have nominated three, Willis Lord, Waterboro; Roger Ridley, Shapleigh; Bruce Gile, Alfred.

Dam Ossipee Lake: Robert Alexander had made inquire on the water level at Ossipee Lake as he would like to do some clean up on the shore.

Ed Waterhouse: Asked that the light at the corner of the Town Hall be checked out. Atkinson's Electric will be called.

Lioness Club:The Club asked permission to sell raffle tickets at the Nov. 6th. election, Board gives their approval.. Annie Ford will be notified.

Ossipee Hill Rd:The Board was unable to get in touch with Town Engineer Walt Stinson, however, Selectman Woodsome gave the following report:

Lewis Thompson called on fence, needs to get cows into field. Thompson said that he talked with someone of Stuart, Torno & Stuart and was told be a worker that his charger wouldn't handle the extra lenght of fencing. After talking with Lewishe agreed to go with electric fence. Woodsome called Stinson and informed him of what was going on. Stinson will call Stuart, Torno & Stuart. Torno is going to work on it Thursday.

Charlir Torno wants to know about the billing. Woodsome told him to do what he wanted to, that Woodsome wasn't happy with what was done and the time frame was going to hurt us in Town Meeting to get another job going and the Board would have to decide what would be paid.
