Selectmen's Meetings.

Dec. 5, 1984:

Horton, Downeast Foods, Inc.: Selectmen Dennis Abbott and Andrew Woodsome, Jr. met on Dec. 5th. with Mr. Donald Horton to review his Plant on Grist Mill Rd. in So. Waterboro, on a request from Mr. Horton for an Industrial Abatement.

1. Smoke House: Section were the bean cookers use to be when the Plant was owned by the DeLong Bean Factory. This building contained a machine for smoking of fish only, by FDA standards no meats can be smoked. This machine was made in Germany and is valued at \$50,000.
2. Packing Room: contains a stainless steel table and scales.
3. Office
4. Small Romm: some refrigeration.
5. Remainder of warehouse is empty.
6. Very little shipped out at this time. Trying to get a Wholesaling Company to handle sales.
7. Mr. Horton seems very sincere and cooperative on showing and explaining the operation.
8. Abbott and Woodsome recommend an Industrial Abatement to help Horton's processing plant.
