Feb. 12, 1985

Public Hearings: Two hearing were held with 18 citizens present. The first hearing was in regards to amending the Town's Crosswalk Ordinance which was adopted March 13, 1982, Annual Town Meeting. Article 25 in this year's Annual Town Meeting will read :To see if the Town will amend its "Crosswalk Ordinance" passed at the Annual Town Meeting held March 13, 1982. Pursuant to Title 30, MRSA, 2151 1C, add the crosswalk at the following designated location, from in front of Blackburn's Campground across Route 5 to the lakefront.

The second hearing was to adopt a Smoke Detector Ordinance in the Town of Waterboro . An Ordinance providing for the installation and maintenance of smoke detectors in all new and existing occupied dwelling units; providing for inspection, offenses and penalties in the Town of Waterboro.

Chief Rankin of the Sanford Fire Department spoke on the Ordinance and the values of it. The Town of Sanford has a similar Ordinance.


Selectman Abbott said that after Town Meeting the Fire Dept., providing the Ordinance passes, should have a campaign for the Ordinance to be enforced. Also Abbott said it would help to have some materials to hand out at Town Meeting.
