Selectmen's Meeting.

Westwinds Subdivision: At the Selectmen's meeting last week Feb 26th., new owner Stuart Gannett met with the Board and discussed the possibility of the Town raising monies to cover the costs of surfacing the roads in the area where homes have been built and then Gannett would pave the roads. Mrs. Randy Drown came to the Board tonight to find out what this was all about. Selectmen explained the money that had been expended in attorney fees, plowing the roads, etc. and they would bring up the sum of \$5,000. to be raised under roads and bridges article. Mrs. Drown assured the Board that she would be at Town Meeting to fight their proposed appropriation. Mrs. Drown said that she would naturally like the road fixed but by Mr. Gannett not the taxpayers.

LA Lot Bid: One bid received from David S. Kelley on Lot 1636 for \$1,015. 30% of the assessed value. The Board accepted this bid Mr. Kelley will be notified.

Clint Strout: Town's auditor from Patterson, Strout Co. met with the Board to go over the Auditor's Report printed in the Annual Town Report. Strout said that the Town could use up to \$100,000. in surplus funds but did not advise them to raise anymore as most of the surplus is in uncollected taxes.


Mr. Strout will attend the Annual Town Meeting to be available to answer any questions of citizens.


Gerry Pare: Called to ask permission to set up a table in the Lobby at Annual Town Meeting, for the Rescue League. Selectmen OK'D this.
