

MINUTES

March 12, 1985 Selectmen's Meeting.

Present: Chairman Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woodsome, Jr., Robert Fay, Jean Chick.

Chairman: Robert Fay nominated Dennis Abbott as the new Chairman, Selectman Woodsome seconded the nomination.

Smoking: Robert Fay made the motion that "no smoking" signs be put in place and not to allow smoking at Selectmen meetings. Seconded by Selectman Woodsome.

Articles: Robert Fay made the motion that the Board accept Articles for future Annual Town Meetings by Town Committees only. Agencies wishing to submit Articles must submit a petition to get on the Warrant. Chrm. Abbott said to add the stipulation that anyone that this office works with, for example he said YCCAC, Notice will be sent to the Agencies with their appropriation checks of this vote.

Jeff Sawyer: In to see the Selectmen concerning his bid (only bid received) for the renovation of the Town building for the accessibility to the handicapped. He was told that the Board would meet with the Self Evaluation Team and the make their decision and that he would be notified of the decision.

Walt Stinson: Selectman Woodsome said that he had talked with Walt regarding meeting with the Board to review the several engineering projects that need to go out to bid, and that he (Walt) could meet on Tuesday, March 19th., however, that date will be the Council Meeting with the students from Massabesic High School. Stinson will be called and another date setup.

Library, Massabesic Lioness: It was moved by Chrm. Abbott to nominate Andrew Woodsome, Jr. to be a Director for the Library. -econded by Selectman Fay.

Doomsday: The Board will ask Mark Caldwell to meet with the citizens and go over their assessment cards on April 6th. The Board will also meet with Mark to discuss the assessing for 1985. It was a vote that the Board have a Contract with Mark and that the deadline for the work to be completed be August 1, 1985.

Stuart Gannett: The Board decided to meet with Mr. Gannett on April 23, 1985 to discuss several matters, meeting set for 8:00 PM.

Council Meeting: The March Council Meeting to be held the 19th. will be a special meeting with the Waterboro students from Massabesic High School attending. Selectman Fay will do a news release on this and Robert Carroll of Saco River Communications, Corp. will be contacted to see if this meeting can be video taped for Cable TV.

Town Hall & Office: The Selectmen discussed that after the renovations for the handicapped were completed that the walls in the Office area be painted and that the rugs be cleaned. The Town Hall ceiling needs to have some of the nails replaced and also be painted.

Roads: Selectman Woodsome reported that there is a problem by the Fire Station in No. Waterboro with water running across the road. Silas Brown Rd. needs some work done, Glenn said that the problem appeared to be that the road is low in areas and floods.

Cross walk signs and stop signs will be ordered. The Crosswalk signs are needed for the Holmes and Blackburn crosswalks.

Bennett Hill Rd, Woodsome said should be blasted where the big rock is and that the ditching be completed to make it ready for the paving.

East Shore Rd. Glenn Bean asked if he should cut some of the trees where the road comes narrow on some of the curves, about 1500 to 2000 feet from the further end. He wants to cut trees and widen, cut right hand side and dig out.

Seal Coat, bids will be sent out tomorrow, must be submitted by April 2, 1985.

Bagley Rd., Glenn Bean asked if it was alright to spend some Roads and Bridges money. Woodsome said that he would have to say no, as this was put before the Town's people and they had voted to spend \$1,000. on the road. Selectman Fay said that he doesn't object. *ABBOTT ALSO SAID HE DIDN'T OBJECT. BOTH ABBOTT AND FAY SAID A SMALL AMOUNT ONLY IF NECESSARY.*

March 26th.: Board of Selectmen will meet with the Self Evaluation Team at 7:30 Pm, and Dwayne Woodsome at 7:45. Robert Carroll of Saco River Communications Corp, will be asked to attend this meeting at 8:00 PM, to discuss the Town having made available to them the TV camera and hook ups, promised when the Town accepted the Franchise Agreement with the Corp.


April 2: On this date the Board plans to award the Stump Dump and Snowplowing Contracts. Also at this time the Board will make the new appointments to the various Town Committees.
