

MINUTES

March 26, 1985, Selectmen's Meeting

Present: Chmn. Dennis Abbott, Robert Fay, Glenn Bean, Sr., Jean Chick.

Town Insurances: Selectmen voted to send a letter to all area Insurance Companies asking them to contact the Town Office if any were interested in submitting prices for all Town Insurances.

Li'l Al's Pizza Barn: Request for a Malt License. A public hearing will be held on April 16, 1985. E. Allen Berube owner will be notified of the time and date, and an ad will be sent to the newspaper.

Mail: Mail delivered to the Town Office which is personally address to a Selectmen will be left unopened for the person to which it was addressed to. This motion made by Chmn. Abbott and seconded by Fay.

Peppercorn Rest: A public hearing held on the issuance of a Liquor License, no citizens in to submit and imput, License signed by the Board members present.

Self Evaluation Team: Members Jean Chick, Cynthia Winslow and Van Foglio met with the Board ot discuss the renovations to the Town Hall for the Handicapped Access Section 504 of the Fed. Rev. Shg. Act. Chmn. Abbott asked Foglio if he felt the only bid received on the renovations was a reasonable bid and Foglio said that he felt it was. However, all agreed that the date of Dec. 1, 1985 for the finalization of the project be moved up. Van Foglio was made "Clerk of the Works" and will get paid by Foglio's say so and will withhold some of the money until all are satisfied with the work. Mr. Sayer of the J.K.I. General Contracting Co. of Gorham will be contacted and asked to meet with the Team and also told that the Board has tentatively accepted his bid and will finalize the acceptance of the bid if the Team gives a favorable recommendation.

Dwayne Woodsome: In to discuss the Stump Dump snowplowing, Woodsome wanted assurance that if he was awarded the East Section Snowplowing bid that the Stump Dump would be cleared of debris to enable him to plow. Fay said that a clause would have to be added to the contract that the area of the Stump Dump would be cleared before snow storms for plowing. Abbott said that perhaps the Town should once again put someone up to the Dump to reeducate people of the proper dumping. Fay said that next year at Annual Town Meeting an Ordinance should be adopted to charge all Contractor's dumping. Glenn Bean said that he felt it was up to Howard Stone to keep the area straight. Stone is the Dump Attendant.

Constable: Selectmen voted to appoint Allan Roberts to become the third Constable for Waterboro.
