July 23, 1985

Selectmen's Meeting.

Present: Chrmn. Dennis Abbott, Andrew Woosme, Jr., Robert Fay, Jean Chick & Glenn Bean, Rd. Commissioner.

Charles Drapeau: In from the Fire Dept. to pick up a key to the Town Dump's gate. He will be issued a key when the Office receives a key to the new gate that Mr. Stevens will be installing at the Dump.

Robert Abbott: In to sign the Snow Plowing Contract for the Northern Section of Town.

Planning Bd: Ernest Roberge, Sr. was appointed as an Alternate member to the Planning Board for one year.

Glen Bean, Rd. Comm: Bean said that the seal coating of roads would be done the last of this week or the first of next week. Woodsome asked Bean what he had planned for this week, Bean said that he would be putting in culverts on Bennett Hill Rd. tomorrow, Woodsome asked if the big rock by Robert Ramsell's property on Bennett Hill Rd. had been removed, Bean said no he couldn't seem to get in touch with Topy Allen to do the work.

Brian Atkinson: In to talk to selectmen about the Gile property located on Map 4 Lot 11. A Joe Cassalanova from New Hampshire has purchased the land and Atkinson said that Mr. Cassalanova has a letter the Mr. Gile received from the Waterboro Industrial Comm. concerning the Town's interest in placing an Industrial Park on this property. The Board was not aware of any letter, asked that Mr. Cassalanova bring the letter with him and meet with the Board and the Town's Industrial Dev. Comm. in August 21st. Mr. Atkinson will see that this Office receives Mr. Cassalanova's address in order to invite him to meet with them.

SAD #57 Director: The Board will hold interviews with the interested citizens that would like to be appointed to Jon Gale's spot on the Board.

The Shelter: Selectman Woodsome said that he had received a request from the Shelter in Alfred that they be given permission to place canisters at the Transfer Station and the Rte. 5 Picnic Area for returnables to help finance a Project they are working on. The Board voted to allow this.

Mark Caldwell: In to work on the assessing, spoke with the Board on abating the property of Antonio Andreottola (former Leather Mill). After discussion it was decided to give \$1,002.85 off his 1984 taxes.
